



FRIEND OF SMILING FEET Volunteer Program

Smiling Feet foot reflexology is formed in April 2008 to help the handicapped (especially the visually handicapped) find a job to sustain their livelihood. As of July 2008, Smiling Feet has a crew of 4 blind therapists, 1 partial deaf therapist and 2 sighted therapists. Smiling Feet is working closely with organizations such as the Singapore Association of the Visually Handicapped (SAVH) and the various training schools to provide job opportunities for the handicapped therapists. In the long term, Smiling Feet plans to have outlets all over Singapore and provide jobs for more handicapped therapists.

Smiling Feet's main objective is to help the handicapped. Smiling Feet pays for and absorbs the handicapped therapists' portion of CPF. Its operational losses is paid for by its parent business, Sandven Group. Sandven Group raised more than S\$120,000 for SAVH in February 2008 through the sale of photographs in an exhibition at the Paragon.

Friend of Smiling Feet is initiated in July 2008 to seek volunteers to help in its daily operation. This will no doubt help to minimize the expenses of Smiling Feet. While we try to keep our expenses minimal, we look forward to more support and volunteers from the public. As a *Friend of Smiling Feet*, you can help out at the outlets assisting the handicapped with the preparation of towels and cream. We will organize workshops for the *Friends of Smiling Feet* to promote awareness on how to better help the handicapped. We also plan to have a mobile team where we have the handicapped therapists doing the therapy on site at the clients' home or in the office with the help of the volunteers.
